Earlier today, the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation announced their next step in job action for Saskatchewan Teachers:

For Friday, February 16, 2024, the STF announced a ONE DAY withdrawal of Noon Hour Supervision.

Logistically, we know that it would be impossible for our students to be supervised safely during lunch during this action. On February 16th, the school day has been altered and shortened to prioritize student safety.

Please note the following:

- **These changes will not impact** students in the EFAP Program, support staff will be supervising during the noon hour.
- **Only AFTER school transportation will be affected for this day.** Our dismissal time will be 1:46pm, and you can anticipate your child(ren)'s bus drop-off times to adjust accordingly.
- **Extra-Curricular continues as planned.** Parents/Guardians will be asked to transport their children to scheduled games.
- **STF Members are expected to leave the building during their lunch hour**
